POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL CARDIOLOGY (PGDCC)

PGDCC programme is a non-invasive clinical cardiology programme implemented in collaboration with Top Cardiac Institutes of the country. Hands on skills training will be provided in the area of ECG and /Stress Testing, Echocardiography, Wards & OPD management of cardiac patients, Management of patient in ICU/CCU, Paediatric Cardiology and Preventing Cardiology. More than 60 cardiac institutes across the country have been designated as training centres of the PGDCC Programme. It is a two year full time programme.

Eligibility – MBBS (MCI Recognized) {Internship has to be completing on or before 31st May, 2012}

Fee – ` 39,600/- per year

Duration – **Minimum**-2 years **Maximum**- 4 years

Selection Procedure – Candidates will be selected on the basis of merit of respective Regional Centre
